UPDATE Regarding COVID-19

* Mandate From the Governor, Masks <u>WILL BE REQUIRED</u>

Kingdom Sports Center will take the necessary precautions when opening the Facility to our Customers as accordingly to the Regulations provided by the Governor.

The Following are going to be our procedures moving forward with scrimmage play in the Facility:

- Temperature checks will be taken for every person or child entering facility.

 Anyone having a temp of 100.4 or higher will be asked to leave.
- A self check should be given at home before your scrimmage. If you are not feeling well or experience any symptoms such as: coughing, sore throat, runny nose, headache, trouble breathing, fainting, throwing up or any other symptoms of COVID 19, please stay home and consult with your local doctor
- The Director will schedule scrimmages apart so that there will be time for staff to clean players seating area, score table area and spectators seating areas. Games will be staggered start times by 10 minutes. Scrimmages will also be spaced 75 minutes to allow 20 minutes to clear and clean the courts.
- Once your scrimmage is completed, please exit promptly outside. No team meetings or congregating allowed. No exceptions. This helps us space apart games and allow for the staff to clean the court before the next scrimmage
- Coaches are not allowed to 'Huddle' with their teams they can talk to players as they sit on the bench No before or after Huddling as well
- Coaches must maintain 6 feet apart from players when instruction from bench at all times. Coaches may remove mask while coaching only, but must wear a mask upon entering and leaving facility.
- Players may not share water bottles or drinks at any time
- Players will sit 6 feet apart on bench. No moving chairs
- Coaches, Officials and spectators of all ages will be required to wear a mask during the scrimmages. Players & coaches must wear a mask upon entering and leaving but may remove during the scrimmage only.
- Coaches will be responsible for sanitation with players if needed

- All Score Tables will have Sanitizing Spray/Paper Towels for customer use
- There are new wall mounted Sanitizing Stations throughout the facility
- Parents/Spectators will practice the 6 ft. distancing on their own
- There will be 'X' marked on floor as well
- Concessions has installed new Plexi-Glass shield for safety of staff/customers
- Masks are mandatory, if you do not have one you can purchase one for \$1 or bring your own in front lobby
- Kingdom Sports Center has the right to deny entry to anyone not following our guidelines and protocols for a safe return to basketball.
- We will have a cashless entry for guests wanting to use Credit Card at the entry table for gate.
- Kingdom Staff will undergo a self test, temp check and remain safe to work
- A sanitation team will be cleaning multiple areas of the facility including, tables, chairs, score tables, player bench and so forth between each game
- Anyone leaving facility and re entering must comply with a temp check and wait in line behind others entering. No exceptions.
- Please form a line spaced 6 feet from others when going through temp check station and gate section. Masks must be worn once you leave your car upon entering facility.
- No parking lot huddles for teams after games, please use other means of team communication
- We ask that anyone with underlying health issues please stay home. As well as anyone who has a higher chance of contracting COVID 19. Our goal is flatten the curve while minimizing the exposure of others.
- Anyone eating or drinking must be stationary sitting down. No eating while walking around. This helps keep everyone spaced apart and ensures masks are worn when walking around someone.
- Scores will be written down on score sheet to score table. However, will not be recorded in app due to gov restriction on scrimmages with being phase 2 return to play rules

Thank you for your cooperation. For us to be allowed to return to basketball, we MUST respect and abide by the Governors orders for us to play scrimmages. If we do not comply, our kids will suffer as we do not want any issues with our scrimmage season. Please understand that our regulations that we must follow are forced down to us and we must follow the safety protocols strictly for us to provide your child a safe place to play.

We are so excited to have you back inside Kingdom Sports Center. Children need sports more than ever now. We cannot wait to see you all.

The Kingdom Sports Center takes this as a serious issue so we want to make sure that our customers are fully informed

We ask that everyone that comes into this Facility use good judgement

If you are sick, stay home-if you have underlying health issues, stay home

We are taking the necessary precautions to keep our facility as clean and sanitized as possible

Feel free to carry your own sanitizer and or paper napkins if needed

We will continue to monitor this situation and follow the guidelines that pertain to COVID 19 and we will keep all our customers informed if anything changes
