

# Kingdom Basketball Academy Club Information For Parents:

Dear Parents,

We want to welcome you to **Kingdom Basketball Academy.** We are happy you have decided to join us and we look forward to having you and your family here at Kingdom.

Included in this packet is information on league dates of play, tournament dates, instructions on accessing our website, and other useful information.

Here at Kingdom Sports Center we pride our self in running a top quality league. Our coaches have gone through an interview process, online background check, and have been handpicked for your child's team. Information regarding your coach, if it has not already been provided, will be provided the week of March 9<sup>th</sup>. We title our teams "Kingdom Academy Basketball" plus the coach's last name. So once you know your coach's last name you will be able to determine what team your child is on. Team names will look like this online: "Kingdom Basketball Academy - [Your coach's name]." Please try to direct all questions about game and/or practice times to your coach. In the case that your coach is unavailable, please call our office @ 937-746-3370.

League schedule will be posted online 2-3 days before games begin. Please note that schedules do change. Your coach will be notified of any changes to the schedule and they should inform you. As a parent we ask that you take the initiative to check the schedule for yourself as well. I have outlined how you can access your child's schedule on the following pages. Your child will also be playing in 7 home tournaments. These are also included in the club price. There are no additional fees for your child to play in our tournaments other than gate admission per tournament and league for spectators (children 17 and under are free!). Dates for the tournaments are included in this packet. In order to view tournament schedules go to our website, click the schedules drop down tab, and then select the "Basketball Tournament Schedule" link. You will then see a clickable link that will open up a schedule on the website. Again, the schedule will be posted 2-3 days in advance and is subject to change. You child will also participate In either training sessions once a week with Mick Dejene (3-6<sup>th</sup> grade) or 1 outside tournament (7<sup>th</sup>-HS) that will be part of your fee.

The Start Date for Training for the 3-6<sup>th</sup> graders will be communicated to your coach – they will keep you informed

The Tournament Date for the Outside Tournament will be communicated to your coach – they will keep you informed and please note there will be a Gate Fee as well for each family member and that will be determined by that Tournament site and may be a different fee then ours-if you purchase a 'PASS' for League/Tournaments for Kingdom Events, this is not acceptable for the Outside Tournament Event.

I hope that this packet of information helps you to have a great experience here at Kingdom Sports Center! We all are excited about kicking off our Spring League! Thanks again for choosing Kingdom!


#### **Tournament Schedules:**

We have an exciting new app that we are using to schedule our tournaments called "Exposure Basketball App." There will be a link on our website that will direct you to the online version of the app, or you can download the app for free on to your smartphone and have access to up-to-the-minute scores and brackets. To get to the schedule from our website, go to www.kingdomsportscenter.com, click the "Schedules" tab, click the tab labeled with the Tournament you are looking for, and then click the button on the page that says, "Click to View Schedule," and you will be redirected to the Exposure Basketball App website. 
Step 1 - choose event




Step 2 - pick division





Step 3 – click schedule

<u>Uniforms:</u> Uniforms will be passed out approximately the week of the first League Game. <u>Your coach will notify you when they are available</u>. **No child** will receive his/her uniform until the club fee has been paid in full. **No exceptions!** Player and parents must come into the office to receive uniform. Coach may pick up uniforms <u>ONLY</u> if the player is paid in full. Parents can call in club fees with credit card payment if needed before any deadlines *We will not be held responsible if you chose a wrong size and the uniform has already been ordered.* 

<u>Training:</u> 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Mick Dejene training dates will be determined and once scheduled, you will be informed by your coach or the office and Schedules are always posted on website

**Outside Tournament:** Will be determined and your coach will inform you 7<sup>th</sup>-HS DIV. ONLY

**Practices:** Coaches will inform parents where practices will be held for team.

Practices will be held at Kingdom, Atrium YMCA (Middletown) or Camp Chautauqua (Miamisburg/Carlisle). Below are directions to the facilities.

#### Directions to Camp Chautauqua: 9985 Camp Trail, Miamisburg, OH, 45342

#### From the North

Travel south down Interstate-75, take Exit 41 for Austin Blvd. toward Miamisburg/Washington Township, use right 2 lanes to turn right onto Austin Blvd., continue onto Miamisburg Springboro Pike, turn left onto Shephard Rd., turn right onto Dayton Cincinnati Pike, Turn left onto Chautauqua Rd., Continue onto Dayton-Oxford Rd., turn left onto Entrance Rd., turn left onto Camp Trail, Destination will be on the left.

#### From the South

Travel north up Interstate-75, take Exit 38 for OH-73 toward Franklin/Springboro, turn left onto OH-73 W/E 2<sup>nd</sup> St., turn right onto Miami Ave., continue onto Dayton-Oxford Rd., continue straight to stay on Dayton-Oxford Rd, turn right onto Entrance Rd., turn left onto Camp Trail, Destination will be on the left.

#### From the East (Waynesville)

Travel west on OH-73, continue onto E 2<sup>nd</sup> St., turn right onto Miami Ave, continue onto Dayton-Oxford Rd., continue straight to stay on Dayton-Oxford Rd., turn right onto Entrance Rd., turn left onto Camp Trail, Destination will be on the left.

#### From the West (Germantown)

Travel south on OH-4 S/Dayton Germantown Pike, turn left onto OH-123 S, Turn left onto Jamaica Rd., Turn right at the 1<sup>st</sup> cross street onto Fairview Dr., Turn left onto Dayton-Oxford Rd., Turn right onto Entrance Rd., Turn Left onto Camp Trail, Destination will be on the left.

#### Directions to Atrium YMCA: 5750 Innovation Dr., Middletown, OH 45005

#### From the North

Travel south on I-75, Use the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the right lane to take Exit 32 for OH-122 toward Middletown, use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto OH-122 E, use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto Union Rd., turn right onto Innovation Dr., destination will be on the left.

#### From the South

Travel north on I-75, take Exit 32 for OH-122 toward Middletown, use the 2nd from the right lane to turn right onto OH-122 E, use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto Union Rd., turn right onto Innovation Dr., destination will be on the left.

#### From the East (Waynesville)

Travel south on US-42 S, turn right onto Middletown Rd./Old 122 Rd., continue onto OH-122 W., Turn right onto Union Rd., Turn right onto Innovation Dr., Destination will be on the left.

#### From the West (Middletown)

Go North on N University Blvd., continue onto Manchester Rd., Turn right onto Union Rd., turn left onto Innovation Dr., Destination will be on the left.

We do follow this so please make sure you do as well.

## **Kingdom Parent/player/spectator Code of Conduct Agreement:**

The Kingdom Sports Center owner, sports directors, and staff have adopted the following conduct policy towards spectators, coaches, league officials, parents, and players.

- I. The following **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** DURING Kingdom Sports Center Basketball events or on Kingdom Sports Center property and action **WILL BE**TAKEN for any of below mentioned behavior:
  - A. Unsportsmanlike behavior, foul or abusive language from any staff member, coaches, players, parents, family members, and/or spectators during Kingdom Basketball practices, games, and/or Events on Kingdom Sports Center or other venues were Kingdom Basketball teams participate.
  - B. Any inappropriate behavior that is considered detrimental to our children, participants, or this organization and its members during basketball functions or on Kingdom Sports Center Property.
  - C. Fighting or other violent behavior from any person involved in any activity of Kingdom Basketball or on Kingdom Property.
  - D. Spectators interference with officials of the on-going game which may not set a good example for players. This may include harassment, verbal language, and conversation related to game while game is in progress with the official. Officials include coaches, scorekeepers and referees.
  - E. Spectators interference with league officials during any game will not be tolerated. This includes before, during and after any league game during any point of the season and post-season tournament. Interference includes verbal, physical, and another other kind of abusive view expressed by the spectator.
  - F. Not following all rules of basketball program rules and related to code of conduct.
  - G. Kingdom players are not allowed to play in another division and/or team without clearance from the Sports Director
- II. Kingdom Sports Center reserves the right to ask any person(s) to remove themselves from a basketball event if Basketball director, member of our staff, and/or league coordinator involved in the current game agrees that the action warrants it.
  - A. Kingdom reserves the right to call local authorities to have any individual removed from our facility if the individual will not peaceably leave the sports center.
  - B. Any person will be held liable for damage or fines incurred during an event such as fines levied by referees, local authorities, or damage done to Kingdom Sports Center.

#### As a parent/guardian I also agree to the following:

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, or practice.

I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable basketball experience for all.

I will remember that my child's game of basketball is for youth - not adults.

I will do my very best to make the sport of basketball fun for my child.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.

I will also treat with respect other players, coaches, fans and officials.

I will help my child enjoy the Kingdom Basketball Academy experience by doing whatever I can to be a respectful fan.

As a parent and fan I will not harass, abuse, disrespect, or cause a disturbance against an opposing coach, player or official. I will remain committed to the Kingdom Code of listed above. Officials have full control over their games.

### WHEN UNIFORMS are Ready For Pick Up

#### WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- You and/or your Coach will let you know when they will be ready for pick up
- Your Coach is there for you to answer any questions you might have
- Make sure you get your Coaches Cell Number
- When you are here for Practices you or your child can pick up their Uniform
- IF YOU OWE you MUST make that payment before you or your child can get their Uniform
- WITH ALL Payments (over\$100) there will be an additional 3% Merchant Fee added

#### No Exceptions to this Procedure

- You will need to get the MANAGER on duty (in concessions) to assist you with getting your child's uniform if it is after 5:00pm M-F.
- **DO NOT** pick your uniforms up on the weekends! Only through the week during your practice times or any time you are here M-Thurs. 9am-9pm
- The Uniform sizes are what you selected so there is no swapping out for a different size all players were to have tried on Uniforms at tryouts or in the office after tryouts.
- If your child's Uniform just completely does not fit then it will be your responsibility to pay for a new one call the office for pricing if this is the case
- Please make sure your child does not leave or lose their uniform here

- League Schedules will be posted after the deadline and about 4 days before the league starts which is Mar. 22<sup>nd</sup>
