2020 Basketball Fall League Rules

1. Scrimmage playing rules will follow protocols issued by State of Ohio Health Dept. to ensure safe play.
2. Scrimmage time is forfeit time – THERE IS NO GRACE PERIOD.
3. Pre-scrimmage warm up is limited to 4 minutes or until the scheduled start time; whichever is sooner. Teams must supply their own balls for warm up, please keep players spaced apart as best as possible
4. Line-ups must be written on the official score sheet in numerical order with a full last name, then first initial. A player MAY NOT play on two teams of the same age division or bracket.
5. The first team listed on the schedule shall wear the lighter colored jerseys and supply the game ball. They will be identified as the home team on the scoreboard and sit to the right of the scorer's table. The home team must also supply an adult as the official scorekeeper.
6. Ball must be disinfected after each game if ball is used again for game after.
7. Scorekeeper MUST keep game score on official score sheet, as supplied by the facility. Game sheets will be turned into Game Director. Scorekeeper MUST record Scrimmage score on league score sheet as posted at the court station. Facility office will pick up score sheet at end of the night.
8. The second team listed on the schedule shall wear the darker colored jerseys. They will be identified as visitors on the scoreboard and will sit to the left of the scorer's table. The visiting team must supply an adult as the official timekeeper/scoreboard operator.
9. Rim height is to be set at 10' for all grades, boys and girls *exceptions for 3rd & 4th grade boys & girls if both teams agree rims can be lowered*
10. No team may 'press' with a 15 point or more lead. Violation of rule" 1st and 2nd offense = Warning, 3rd offense = Team Technical Foul.
11. No Zone defense will be permitted for 3-6th grade, boys or girls. Man to man defense only is allowed. Zone defense will be allowed for 7-HS boys and girls as well as man to man.
12. All adults must wear mask entire game, as well as officials. No exceptions. Players must wear masks as well as children when entering building. Only players may take off masks when on the court at their game time. Must be worn before and after game.
13. Any parent of family member including children must wear masks in stands the entire duration of the scrimmage while inside the facility. If you are not wearing a mask, you will be asked nicely to put one on, if you do not comply, you will be removed from facility.
14. Guests, coaches, fans, players may remove mask only to eat or drink while stationary sitting down. No one is permitted to eat or drink while moving. This is to ensure we limit exposure of germs inside facility. Masks must be worn immediately following your meal or drink. Thank you
15. Pre game procedure, parents and team must wait until the benches and stands are cleared by the teams before, before sitting down
16. Post game procedure, parents and team must exit the court and facility promptly, no after scrimmage huddles at all. We must leave court. Post game sanitation will be in effect after each game is completed.
17. All girls' teams and 3rd-7th grade boys' teams will use the 28.5 inch ball. The 8th-12 grade boys' teams will use the full size ball.
18. All game will be (2) 20 minute running clock half's. Running clock entire half. No stop and go. Time out stops clock only
19. The time between halves is limited to 3 minutes.

20. A player will be disqualified after 5 personal fouls.

21. The bonus free throw will be awarded starting with the 7th foul of a half and the double bonus will go into effect with the 10th foul of a half.

22. All flagrant and technical fouls will be 2 shot fouls, plus the team will get the ball.

23. Any player, coach. Or fan receiving 2 technical fouls in a scrimmage must leave the court immediately and may not have any further contact with their team for the remainder of that scrimmage. If they do not leave the court immediately, the game will be forfeited. The Facility Director can suspend the person for the remainder of the season.

24. Overtime, 1 minute only. If team score is still tie, a tie is written down as official score. No extra overtime granted.

25. Dunking is only permitted during scrimmage time. Dunking IS NOT permitted during warm up time. Team Technical will be enforced.

26. No protests are allowed – problems must be solved immediately during the scrimmage.

27. No non-uniformed children are allowed on the team's bench at any time, this includes injured players who are not in uniform.

28. Players must be spaced out 6 feet apart on bench chairs. No moving of the chairs

29. Team may not huddle or congregate at any point during game, prior to scrimmage, or after scrimmage. This is in accordance to the Health Dept Rules for July 4th order.

30.. Two coaches is permitted on bench, one adult at score table per team (2 Total Adults at score table, clock and scorebook)

31. Teams MUST be paid in FULL; prior to tip off of their first scrimmage.

32. All rosters are to be turned in before first game and are final at start of first game.

33. All questions regarding playing rules, eligibility, procedures, etc. Need to be directed to the game manager. The Director's decisions are final.

34. Scores will be written down on score sheet on score table. However, scores cannot be posted to app for customers viewing due to governors' orders on phase 2 contact sports return to play rules.

35. 2 – 30 second time outs, can only use 1 per half
